Staff answered approximately **9,080** questions in-person, on the phone, at the window, by email or by text!

SNHL conducted 1758 programs for all ages with 64,380 attendees. That is a savings of \$321,900. (\$5.00 per person)

A look back at 2023

- Shaler Township converted all library lighting to LED.
- Library Market, a new library-wide programming calendar was implemented.
- Pittsburgh Collage Collective & Berkley Commonplace displayed 90 hand-cut collages in July.
- 600 donors contributed to the "Bottoms Up" Campaign to upgrade the 2nd floor restrooms and install a 1st floor restroom for a total of \$51,000 during the month of September. The Jack Buncher Foundation gave a prorated match of \$9,000 for Love Your Library.
- SNHL hosted the streaming premiere of "Perseverance" performed at Prime Stage Theatre with author Lee Kikel and playwright, LE McCullough.
- Stories and Songs in your Neighborhood visited four amazing sites every week in the summer and early fall!
- Act Out Readers' Theatre debuted an adaptation of "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" and produced a holiday theatre for adults.





